## **Governor Huntsman Appoints Two New Board of Regents Members**

**Salt Lake City** – Governor Jon Huntsman appointed Reverend France Davis and student representative Basim Motiwala as new members of the Utah State Board of Regents.

“Reverend France Davis has admirably contributed to the Board of Trustees for Salt Lake Community College,” said Governor Huntsman. “Our System of Higher Education will benefit from his proven leadership, knowledge, and experience in building and creating post secondary education opportunities for Utahns.”

Rev. Davis is currently a member of the Salt Lake Community College Board of Trustees. He is also the full-time pastor of the Calvary Baptist Church in Salt Lake City and has been for more than 30 years. Rev. Davis has earned several degrees, including a Master's degree from the University of Utah. His name has been sent to the Utah State Senate, pending confirmation.

Basim Motiwala, a senior at the University of Utah, will serve as the 32<sup>nd</sup> student representative on the Utah State Board of Regents. Motiwala was one of three finalists recommended by the Utah Council of Student Body Presidents for appointment on the board, and will serve a one-year term as the Student Regent.

“Basim is highly respected by his peers and the University,” said Governor Huntsman. “His outstanding leadership experience among students will be a great asset to the Board of Regents.”

Motiwala has held several student leadership positions, most recently as the 2007-2008 Student Body Vice-President, as well as the Student Director of Campus Relations in 2006. He is currently seeking a Bachelor of Science degree in Behavioral Science and Health.
